



Richmond Highway Widening (Mount Vernon Memorial Highway/Jeff Todd Way to Sherwood Hall Lane)



Project Description

The project will provide multimodal improvements, including roadway widening, along the 3.1-mile section of Richmond Highway (US Route 1) between Mt. Vernon Memorial Highway/Jeff Todd Way and Sherwood Hall Lane in Fairfax County. This project will increase the number of through travel lanes along Richmond Highway from four lanes to six lanes. In addition, it will provide a median reservation for future Bus Rapid Transit (BRT), intersection improvements, the replacement of two bridges, secure pedestrian crossings, as well as eight-foot wide off-road two-way bicycle paths and six-foot wide sidewalks on both sides of the road.
